And as to what worldly substance it has
pleased God to bless me with I will and
bequeath in manner and form following (to wit)
My will and desire is that all my property
of every name kind and description
of cattle, hogs, monies, household and other
things be equally divided between my
son John Carnes, my daughter
Polly Parrish wife of James Parrish, and
Mary daughter Mary Legant wife of Williams
Legant of Person County, share and share
alike to them and their heirs forever, except
that my will and desire is that my daughter
Polly Parrish wife of James Parrish, afore-
said shall have my gold watch and
that my daughter Mary Legant
wife of Williams Legant, afore-said shall
have my clock previous to the equal divi-
sion of my property afore-said. Lastly I
do hereby constitute and appoint George W. Jones
my executor to this my last will and
testament, hereby revoking all wills
by me heretofore made. Given un-
