In the Name of God amen I William White of Chester District and State of South carolina being of Sound and disposing Mind and momery but weak in body and calling to mind the uncertanty of life and being desirous to dispose of all such worldy estate as it hath pleased God to bless me with-do make and ordain this my last Will in manner following that is to say-------

I desire that all my Just debts be immediately paid and my funeral expences is to be paid also and after my debts and funeral expences is payed I give to my Beloved Wife Jane White all my reserved Right of my Plantation whereon I now live for the Tim-of her natural life all all my Personal property consisting of one Negro Woman named Patto & her daughter Beck also alll my money on ha d and on interes also till my goods & Chattles to my wife for the term of her natural life, and after hir decease. Hy Will is that all the property that is at her death Shall bi divided Equally among my Six Sons Viz John White Hugh White William White Abraham White Frances White & Garwer White Share and Share alike---As to my Son John White I have given him one Negro Girl named Sarah and he has sold her to Frances White-eas to my Son Hugh White I have given him one Hegre Girl named Nance. as to my son William White I have given him a Negro bey named Milson--asto my Son Abraham White I have given him a Negro girl and he has Sold hir to Hugh White (Hegro girl named Rish) As to my Son Frances White I have given him a Negro boy named day----asto my Son Garner White I have given him a Negro girl named Rachel--as to the above named Negroes given to my Sons, I do this to confirm the right in them forever----As to my Son James White and his hiers I have given him all that I alow him as I considered it a full Share at that him, and him & his heirs is to have no more--- As to my Son Samuel White I alow him what he has got also else one hundred Dollars at any time hereafter an no more as to my daughter Elisabeth Bishop & hir hiers I give her no more than She has get as I considered it a full Share at that time--and lastly I do constitute and appoint my Son John White William

White & Hugh White executors of this my last Will and testementby me heretefore made, In testimony whereof, I have hereunto Set my hand and affixed my Seal this Twentjeth day of Novemberin the year of Our Lord One Thousand Right hundred and Thirty Thirde----Signed, Sealed, published and declared as and for my the last will and testament of the above William White in the presence of us
