Next I give and Bequeath unto my son Joseph Lowery fifty Dollars, I leave also to my Son James Lowery fifty Dollars. also I leave to my son William Lowery one hundred Dollars. also I leave to my son Robert Lowery fifty Dollars, as all their shares or Claims to any part of the Estate after my Deccase. also I give to my son John Lowery all the Notes and Book accounts Due by him to me as his Divid share of my Estate at my Decease and if the said Notes and accounts Do not amount fifty Dollars it shall be made up that sum. I also give and Bequeath unto my sons/exander Lowery and Thomas Lowery three hundred and fifty Dollars Each for their part of the Estate at my Decease and I leave all the rendinder of my Estate namely one hundred acres of Land that I now Live on all my household goods and Chattles after paying my sons off their shares, to my three Daughters namely Mary Galloway Elisabeth Lowery and Susannah Boyd to Be Equally Divided amongst them, the two Negroes named Crifsey and Ben.
