Fourthly, --- I direct and require My Executors to Expand the Sum of one th-usend dellare in purchasing two negro Girls Which Said two negro Girls So purchased, I dive and bequeath to my Sister Susan Boyd wife of John Boyd during her natural life and at her death I dive the Said two negro Girls with their Increas, if any, to my Meece Jane Marria. Boyd. her & her Heire forever. It is my will and desire that the use and Services of the Said two negro Girls. to my Said Sister during her natural life be held by My Said Sister from the Centrel or power of her husband and that the Said negros are not to be answerable or bound in any manner for any present or futre

debts or contracts of the Said John Boyd

Fifthly I Give and bequeath to My Mephew James Lowery Son of Joseph Lowery of Georgia, the Sum of Ten Thousand dollars to him and his Heire forever.

Sixthly----I Give and bequeath to my Hepher. David Lowery.

Son of Joseph Lowery of Georgia the Sum of Two thousand
dollars to him and his Heire forever.

Seventhly--- Give and bequeath to My Grand Maphew James
Lowery Son of James G Lowery, the Sum of Five hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever.

Eighthly---I Give and bequeath to James J Chanon the Sum of Two thousand dellars to him & his heirs forever Minthly---I give and bequeath to the board of Domestic messions under the control of the General Assemble of the Presbyterian Church the Sum of One thousand dellars for to be used for the purpose of Domestic Missions

Tenthly I give and bequeath to the bound of Foreign Missions under the Control of the General assembly of the Presbyterian Church, the Sumof one thousand dollars forever to be used for the purpose foreign missions

Eleventhly.—It is my will and desire that all of my Negros which may not be Sold at the time of my death be Hired out privality untill My Executor can the Sale of them, at private Sale, and it is my will that they be not Sold at public auction and that they be Sold to persons who will likely treat them well.

Tweirth. I Give and bequeath My Gold Watch, Chain and Key to Mrs. Susan Hay. Sister of James J Obanon to her and her heirs forever.

Thirteenth It is my will and desire that my negro women named Rose Commonally Called big Rose be not Sold and it is My will and desire that Said Hegro Rose de live with My Nephews. John Thomas / or James G Lowery, which Ever She may choose or preference alternately with them if She Choses, during her life, and that with whomsoever She lives, that they pay no huse for her that they feed and clothe her for Such Services as he may render than, or Either of them.

as a house Servent, and income My Said Hephews Should die before the Said Rose, then that She remain with Rither of their famelies, as She may Choose or prefer, on the Same terms. In as much as as the Said Rose has been a faithful Servant and Kind to me in My Sickness----I request My Said-Mephews to keep-her treat her as Kindly as they reasonably can for Said Servises.

Fourteenth. It is my will that My Trasutors purchase in reasonable time the two negro girls mentioned in the fourth Clause of My Will and deliver them to my Sister Susan Boyd, according to the tenon and Conditions mentioned in the Said fourth Clause, My Said Sister to receive them herself. or Some person duly authorised by her to receive them. Fifteenth -- I give and bequeath the rest & remainder of My property and Estate of Every Kind, description whatever to the Sons and daughters of my brother Joseph Lowery the Sons and daughters of My Brother Robert Lowery, the Sons of My Brother John Lowery, the Sons and daughers of My Sister Mary Galloway, the Sons and daughters of My Sister Susan Boyd. (embracing Such of her Sons and daughters only, as are resident in the State of South Carolina at the date of this My Will, Share and Share alike to them and theirs Heirs forever. Sixteenth I will and bequeath, that the dress clothing of My deceased beloved wife Serah H Lowery be Equally divided between My Sister Mary Gallaway and Mrs. Susan Hay forever---Seventeenth, I will the portrate of myself & that of my decease ed Wife Sereh H Lowery to my Nephew John Thomas Lowery foreven The Sixteenth and Seventeenth clauses to Come in and be read before the fifteenth clause
