I David Moffet of Chester District and
State aforesd. being in sound mind and

memory do ordain and appoint this my last will and Testament.

--Viz---

IMPRIMIS TO my wife Mary. I will and bequeath my plantation whereon I now live for her to occupy or use for her support and maintainence, during her natural life, and at her death --should the child with which she is now pregnant be living, I leave and bequeath the plantation to such Said child--otherwise the land to go to the benefit of the whole of my heirs.--

Item To my wife Mary I will and bequeath my negro woman Nance, also two horses and as much of my household and Kitchen furniture and farming Utensils, as my executors hereinafter named shall think necessary and sufficient. Also as much provisions and stock of all kinds I have as my said Executors shall think proper and necessary for her.

Item To my Daughter Letitia B. Miller and her husband James Miller, I will and bequeath twenty five Dollars in addition to what I have already given them.---

Item The whole residue of my estate, I wish divided among my Daughters, Eliza, Martha, and Polly and my Sons William Strong James, Samuel, and Charles Christopher in such manner, that my said three Daughters shall have equal shares, and my said four sons, equal shares and for each son's portion, to be one third more, than the portion of each Daughter.

Item Should unfourseen circumstances, render my younger children viz my four sons, as also the one with which my wife is pregnant, unable to pay for their common and usual schooling--it is my will, that a necessary and equitable portion to be taken from each and every one of my other heirs except my daughter Letitia B. Miller and her husband James Miller, for the purpose of Educating them the said younger children, in the common endiments of an english education--but it is to be distinctly understood, that this is to be resorted to only if

a absolutely necessary: of which necessary my executors are to be the Judges.--In Conclusion. I appoint my Brother William Moffet Merchant. and my Brother in law Co.¹ John Moffet & my Executors, to carry into effect this my last will and Testament.
