to enter into and upon all and singular the goods and chattels, rights and credits of the said Bessie S. Boyd deceased,

and the same in your possession take whatsoever the same may be found, and a true and perfect inventory thereof to make, and return to our ensuing County Court, and all just debts of the said Bessie S. Boyd

deceased to pay; and also well and truly pay and deliver all the legacies contained and specified in said Testament, as far as the said goods, chattels and credits will thereunto extend and the law charge you.
